

5 year Bible reading plan – week 3

Week 2 – 27/11/16

Monday: Matthew 2:1-12. Interesting to note that the first people to worship Jesus were Gentiles. The Jewish leaders knew where Jesus was to be found but did not search for him. Choose to bow down & worship Him today.

Tuesday: Genesis 3:1-24. As Adam & Eve sinned we see a God who sought to seek those who were lost. He knew where they were, yet he called out & waited for a response. Pray for those who are lost that they would respond to a God who came to seek & save the lost.

Wednesday: Proverbs 1:1-7. Proverbs' theme is wisdom, giving practical wisdom based on obedience to God's commands that will help in everyday living. If you need wisdom, 'fear the Lord', acknowledge God's power & sovereignty & then obey His instruction.

Thursday: Joshua 3:1-17. After 40 years, the day has finally come for the Israelites to enter the Promised Land. As they move forward there were some important steps to follow. What were the instructions that were given that we can apply to our own lives?

Friday: Romans 2:1-16. This passage focuses on God's judgment & the importance of it. It lets us know that the only way of salvation is through God's grace. What event in your life led you to appreciate God's grace?

Weekend: Isaiah 2:1-22. Isaiah returns from the vision of the future (vv1-5) to the reality of the present, where man has filled his life with the treasures of this world, which have become full of pride. He ends by saying, "stop trusting in man". What are you trusting in today? Put your trust in God alone.
