

## 5 year Bible reading plan – week 4

### Week 4 – 4/12/16

**Monday: Matthew 2:13-18.** On four occasions we are told that God spoke to Joseph through a dream. How do you normally hear God speak and how open are you for him to use different means?

**Tuesday: Genesis 4:1-26.** Cain's anger was unchecked, and as a result he committed murder. How well do you deal with your negative emotions? Do you recognise them as sin and quickly confess and turn away from them by changing your behavior and attitude?

**Wednesday: Psalm 4:1 - 5:12.** Make Ps 5:3 your example as you focus on the fact that God hears prayer, and lift up your needs to Him with expectant faith today.

**Thursday: Joshua 4:1-24.** The pile of stones was a reminder of God's power to pass on to the next generation (v6), as well as having an immediate impact (v26). What do you do to remind yourself of answered prayer and God's past miracles?

**Friday: Romans 2:17-29.** The apostle makes it clear that birth and outward conformity does not count. A "Jew" is one who experiences the Spirit in his life (vv 27, 28). Outward conformity is less important than an inward relationship with Jesus.

**Weekend: Isaiah 3:1-26.** In poetic language the Prophet sets out the problem with Jerusalem the capital of Judah and foretells of coming judgment. What would he proclaim over our nation?
