

## 5 year Bible reading plan – week 7

### **Week 7 – 25/12/16**

**Monday: Matthew 3:13-17.** Jesus Christ was conceived (Mt 1:20), baptized (Mt 3:16), anointed (Lk 4:18), guided (Lk 4:1), empowered (Lk 4:14), and filled with the Holy Spirit (Lk 10:21). He lived dependent on and in union with the Holy Spirit. Do you follow his example?

**Tuesday: Genesis 7:1-24.** The flood was a devastating judgement upon the appalling selfishness and evil of people. Yet God graciously saves Noah and offers a new beginning. Today is a new day for you! Confess yesterday's mistakes and re-commit to serving Jesus!

**Wednesday: Psalm 8:1-9.** When David looked at Creation (v3) it brought him a sense of perspective about people in general and his own life in particular. Seeing God's greatness compared to our weakness should always produce awe and worship!

**Thursday: Joshua 7:1-26.** Sin and compromise always make us weak and cause us to fail when our enemy attacks. Sin always requires judgement. Take time to examine yourself, confess your sins, and look to Jesus, who took God's anger and judgement instead of us.

**Friday: Romans 4:1-15.** Paul is emphasizing that people have always been saved by faith alone. It is when we believe what God says that we obtain what he promises. Faith is agreeing that what God says is true despite the circumstances or what we feel! Confess your faith in Him again today!

**Weekend: Isaiah 6:1-13.** When Isaiah really saw God's purity, he realised his own impurity. It was God's holiness that motivated his worship and his service. Have you really recognized God's holiness?
