

5 year Bible reading plan – week 9

Week 9 – 8/1/17

Monday: Matthew 4:12-17. Here in the life of Jesus, there was a time for change. Jesus knew that for every event in his life there was an appointed time. Keep trusting in God's plan. Listen and walk in the light of his instructions.

Tuesday: Genesis 9:1-29. After the flood, God gave Noah and his descendants a covenant promise. As you have gone through difficult moments, what promises or words of encouragement did you receive that gave you hope?

Wednesday: Proverbs 1:20-33. As 'Wisdom' shouts out to be heard, what can we learn about its content, tone and possible impact upon our lives? Choose to fear the Lord and walk in His wisdom today.

Thursday: Joshua 9:1-27. Sometimes it is easier just to do our own thing, as to enquire of the Lord could take time, effort and energy. What do you feel the Israelites would say to us from what they learnt?

Friday: Romans 5:1-11. Paul points out the blessings of justification: the past blessing of peace with God (v1), the present blessing of grace (v2) and the future blessing of the hope of the glory of God. Rejoice in what Christ has done for you.

Weekend: Isaiah 8:1-22. We find here that human strategies and plans cannot succeed if they oppose God's purposes. Today, wait for God's instruction and put your trust in his plans and purposes for your life.
