

5 year Bible reading plan – week 10

Week 10 – 15/1/17

Monday: Matthew 4:18-25. This was a period of great popularity as people travelled up to 50 miles over a few days to see Jesus. What does this tell you about them, and what does the effort you make to connect with Jesus say about you?

Tuesday: Genesis 10:1-32. Nimrod is singled out as a hunter and a warrior king, (vv8-12) and reference is made to his relationship with God. When people describe you, is your involvement with Jesus something that is obvious?

Wednesday: Psalm 10:1-18. What stands out in this psalm for you? Turn it into an expression of praise to God!

Thursday: Joshua 10:1-15. Joshua felt obliged to respond to the Gibeonites request, because he had made a treaty with them, even if in error. Do you take your promises as seriously, even when you made them rashly or by mistake?

Friday: Romans 5:12-21. This is very deep but contains important truths. Adam's fall brought sin and death to humanity and only when we come to faith in Christ can we experience grace and life in Christ. Are you enjoying Christ's abundant provision? If not, why not?

Weekend: Isaiah 9:1-21. Consider the names of Jesus in v6. Meditate upon them and consider what they reveal, before spending time praising him for what they tell us about him.
