

5 year Bible Reading plan – week 100

Week 100 - w/c 7/10/18

Monday: Mark 14:66-72. In v31 Peter was absolutely certain he would never disown Jesus, but that same night he does so three times. Why do you think he did? Why did he break down and weep (v72)? Thank God that God does not cast us away when we fail him – Peter's greatest opportunities and successes came after this time of failure.

Tuesday: Leviticus 1:1-17. We are not called to worship in the tabernacle like Israel did. Instead our whole life is intended to be an act of worship, honouring God by what we do. We are not called to bring a lamb as a sacrifice of worship (v3). Instead, Jesus has died to enable us to enter God's presence, and we offer up our body as a living sacrifice. Is your current life of worship pleasing to the Lord?

Wednesday: 2 Samuel 15:1-37. For four years, Absalom plotted against his father (v7), but the issues that led up to this rebellion had taken root many years earlier. Are there issues in your past that have been allowed to fester? Ask God to reveal anything that you need to deal with, by bringing it before him and asking him to help you deal with it in a Biblical manner.

Thursday: Psalm 78:1-31. One of the key verses for our Church Mission Statement is found in verse 4. It is so important we pass on to the next generation the truth of what God has done. We do so through our emphasis on evangelism, discipleship and HomeFront – equipping parents to disciple their children effectively. Are you playing your part?

Friday: Jeremiah 29:1-32. Verse 11 and verse 13 are verses which many people find encouraging. Which of these speaks most to you today or is there another verse which is more significant in today's reading. Ask God to apply His word in your life and show you how you should respond to it in your daily activity.

Weekend: Galatians 6:1-10. In the light of today's reading, take time this weekend to talk to God and examine your own heart using the following questions: Have I fully explored who I am? What work have I been given to do? Am I in danger of being impressed with myself? Who am I in danger of comparing myself with? Am I taking responsibility for doing the creative best with my life?
