<u>5 year Bible Reading plan – week 104</u>

Week 104 - w/c 4/11/18

Monday: Mark 16:1-20. Look at the question the women were asking in v3. Praise God that if our desire to meet him is genuinely based on faith and love for him, the obstacles we fear are nothing compared with the ability of God to remove everything that would be a hindrance.

Tuesday: Leviticus 4:13-35. Cf. verses 22, 23 with verses 27, 28. Leaders were treated differently and expected to have a higher standard than others. Why do you think this was? Thank God that the death of Jesus Christ is the only sin offering needed for us today!

Wednesday: 2 Samuel 19:1-43. Joab would have been a much harsher ruler than David, because he was always wanting to do things his way. David tried to do what he felt was right, yet he won over the hearts of all the men (v14). What can you learn from Joab and David's different approaches?

Thursday: Psalm 80:1-19. "Restore us make your face shine upon us, that we may be saved." The phrase occurs 3 times in this Psalm. The author made it his passionate prayer, for a fresh experience of God for him and God's people. Make this your prayer for yourself and the Church today!

Friday: Jeremiah 32:1-23. Read verse 17 again. Are you as convinced as Jeremiah that nothing is too hard for our God, who created the heavens and earth? What will you pray for today that is impossible to see happen by human effort, but that God can do for those who exercise faith?

Weekend: Ephesians 2:1-10. Based on verses 8-10, Neil Anderson comments "It's not what you do as a Christian that determines who you are; it's who you are that determines what you do." How will who you are as a Child of God influence how you behave this weekend?
