

5 year Bible reading plan – week 18

Week 18 – 12/3/17

Monday: Matthew 9:18-34. If you had to give a definition about “faith” out of these stories, what would you say: Faith is.....?

Tuesday: Genesis 18:1-15. What a wonderful truth for each of us to ponder today that when we face tasks that seem impossible, the Lord says, “Is anything too hard for me?”.

Wednesday: Proverbs 3:1-10. As we take hold of God’s instructions, what benefits do we experience in our lives from these few verses? Be wise and put them into practice.

Thursday: Joshua 17:1-18. The people of Joseph felt restricted, longed for more room but were afraid of the enemy. Joshua encouraged them to go and take hold of the land, to focus on who they were and what they could do in God. Don’t allow the enemy to hold you back, but take hold of everything God has for you.

Friday: Romans 9:14-29. Paul used Exodus 33:19 to show the freedom of God’s mercy. How do you feel about God’s authority to choose who will be objects of his mercy?

Weekend: Isaiah 19:1-25. As we read vv16-22, how was God going to turn things around? What response was he looking for? Pray today that lives will ‘fear the Lord’, ‘call on his name’ & ‘worship God alone’.
