

5 year Bible reading plan – week 19

Week 19 – 19/3/17

Monday: Matthew 9:35 - 10:16. Jesus not only called the twelve but he gave them power to do what he had called them to do. The same principle holds true today: whom God calls, God equips. Who will you share your faith with or pray for?

Tuesday: Genesis 18:16-33. Abraham's repetition demonstrated his sincere desire to save his relatives. Who are you interceding for and what will you do, to see them take a step closer to knowing Christ?

Wednesday: Psalm 18:20-31. In verses 20-24 we see that God delivered David from a long season of affliction under Saul. David conducted himself in righteousness, and knew that God rewarded him because of it. Glorify God in the way you deal with others today.

Thursday: Joshua 18:1-28. For some reason seven tribes hesitated in taking possession of that which God had given to them. What are you holding back from in your own life and why? What can we learn from Joshua in the way that he dealt with the problem?

Friday: Romans 9:30 - 10:13. Give thanks to God today for your salvation recognizing that it's not about what you have done, but it's all about what Christ has done on the cross.

Weekend: Isaiah 20:1 - 21:17. Here God shows Judah how foolish it will be for them to look to and put their trust in other nations instead of trusting in God. Today, put your trust in God and depend on him for everything.
