

5 year Bible reading plan – week 21

Week 21 – 2/4/17

Monday: Matthew 10:34-42. Jesus challenges us to love him more than anyone else in our lives. And to demonstrate it by our actions towards other disciples. Is there anything you need to change in order to fulfill this today?

Tuesday: Genesis 20:1-18. Abraham deceives Abimelech assuming wrongly that Abimelech would not respect God (v11). Don't make wrong assumptions about people's responses an excuse to not share your faith or invite them to Church!

Wednesday Proverbs 3:11-20. We need to grow in wisdom more than we need to make money, according to verses 13 & 14. Do you put as much effort into building your character and understanding, as you do paying bills and managing your finances?

Thursday: Joshua 19:49-20:9. God was laying the foundation for a new nation and right at the heart of it he makes provision for refuge and forgiveness for accidental killing. Thank God that Christ's death makes forgiveness of any sin possible.

Friday: Romans 11:1-24. Paul makes it clear that Israel has not been totally or finally rejected. He was living proof that the Jews could still be saved by faith, and he longs for others of his own race to come to saving faith in Christ. Do you have the same passion for the salvation of your nation?

Weekend: Isaiah 23:1-18. God's reasons for bringing judgement on Tyre are found in verse 9. God still humbles the proud, but it is always easier to humble ourselves than be humbled by God's judgement.
