

5 year Bible reading plan – week 22

Week 22 – 09/4/17

Monday: Matthew 11:1-19. Prison raised some doubts for John but Jesus stirs his faith. In times of discouragement and doubt, what renews your faith?

Tuesday: Genesis 21:1-34. Sometimes we find ourselves in desert places without water, running on empty, with no hope. Today, we have assurance that God hears our cry, he opens our eyes bringing clear direction and he refreshes and strengthens us for the journey ahead.

Wednesday: Psalm 19:1-14. God gave us divine law as both warning and promises. What benefits does the Psalmist reveal to us as we choose to live in his will?

Thursday: Joshua 21:1-45. List the many things God had done for Israel (vv 43-45). What aspects of the Lord's nature shine through these blessings?

Friday: Romans 11:25-36. The word doxology comes from the Greek doxa (glory, splendor) and logos (word or speaking). Just as Paul did, why not speak out praise to God for all his blessings and declare who he is to you.

Weekend: Isaiah 24:1-23. Isaiah draws the end time into focus. For him the final judgment was certain and could happen at any moment. If you knew that today was the last day, would you live your life any differently, and if so what would you focus on?
