

## 5 year Bible reading plan – week 37

### **Week 37 - 23/7/17**

**Monday: Matthew 17:1-13.** As Peter was speaking God interrupts him to affirm the unique identity of Jesus, “This is my Son”, and that he deserves our attention, “Listen to him”. Today, don’t allow things to distract you but be still in God’s presence and allow him to capture your attention and speak into your life.

**Tuesday: Genesis 31:22-55.** Laban was not very happy with Jacob because he had run off secretly and deceived him. How did Laban and Jacob finally resolve their differences and what lessons can we learn from them?

**Wednesday: Judges 12:1-15.** Compare Judges 12:1-4 and Judges 8:1-3. How do Jephthah and Gideon differ in their response? What is usually your first response to a threatening situation?

**Thursday: Psalm 30:1-12.** Through the hard times that David faced, he praises God for:  
1. The healing God brings (1-3) 2. The joy God gives (4-5) 3. The security God provides (6-7)  
4. The future God opens (8-10) 5. The change God works (11-12). Praise Him in all things.

**Friday: Isaiah 37:21-38.** When have you felt like Hezekiah – backed up against a wall with no recourse but to pray? How have you seen God’s affirmation of his love for you? Know today that God hears our cry and the battle belongs to him.

**Weekend: 1 Corinthians 3:1-9.** Paul was the first to preach in Corinth. Apollos ‘watered’, he continued Paul’s work by helping to build a new church but notice, God made it grow. In whose lives are you planting or watering? Pray that we will see growth in those whom we have had the privilege of coming alongside.
