

## 5 year Bible reading plan – week 39

### Week 39- 6/8/17

**Monday: Matthew 18:1-14.** It has been said that the smaller you make yourself in God's kingdom, the bigger the landscape of God's greatness will appear to be. Is this part of what Jesus meant in verse 4?

**Tuesday: Genesis 33:1-20.** Jacob was afraid about meeting Esau, but his fears were groundless. Esau was not bitter but welcomed him! Often our worries are worse than the reality.

**Wednesday: Judges 14:1-20.** For Samson, wrong relationships were a weakness that led to his downfall. In what areas of your life must you guard against falling into sin? Confess your weakness and ask for God's strength.

**Thursday: Proverbs 5:15-23.** Are you conscious that your "ways are in full view" of God and that he sees your heart, your actions, your motives? How should this thought make you feel, and respond?

**Friday: Isaiah 39:1-8.** Hezekiah was not wise in dealing with the Babylonians, and was less concerned about the next generation as long as he was secure! Are you leaving behind a legacy that will help those who come after you or are you only focused on the present?

**Saturday: 1 Corinthians 4:1-13.** Are you proving faithful in using what God has entrusted to you? Verse 2 is a reminder that we must use our resources, gifts, talents, ministry opportunities, witnessing wisely! Do a mental check up on how well you are doing!
