

## 5 year Bible reading plan – week 58

### **Week 58 - 17/12/17**

**Monday: Matthew 25:31-46.** Just as Jesus served the poor and needy, both physically and spiritually, so we should do the same. How might you make a difference to someone else's life today?

**Tuesday: Genesis 50:1-14.** As Joseph's father dies, they spend seventy days in mourning, two days short of the mourning period for an Egyptian Pharaoh, indicating how much respect they had for Joseph. What would those around you say about your character?

**Wednesday: 1 Samuel 7:1-17.** The Israelites gained a victory over the Philistines at Mizpah. What did they do that we can apply to our own life and circumstances?

**Thursday: Psalm 44:1-26.** The psalmist seems to be struggling. They have heard and been told of how God moved in years gone by, but why is God silent now? How is your faith in God's justice and love affected when it appears that God is neglecting you in your situation?

**Friday: Isaiah 56:1-12.** God promised Abraham that through him all peoples of the world would be blessed. People everywhere who repent and come to God are welcomed into his kingdom with joy. Who are you praying for today and long for them to be saved?

**Weekend: 1 Corinthians 12:31-13:13.** Looking at the descriptions of perfect love in verses 4-7, in which one of these descriptions are you strongest and which one do you need to work at? What will you do today to strengthen that area of weakness?
