

5 year Bible reading plan – week 61

Week 61 - 07/01/18

Monday: Matthew 26:31-46. No doubt we have all faced a 'long night', thinking about the situation that we are faced with. What do we learn about the humanity of Jesus and what model does he give us when it comes to prayer?

Tuesday: Exodus 2:1-25. The comment made by the man in v14, would one day become a reality, where Moses would rule, judge and deliver his people, however, Moses wasn't ready at this stage. As you look back over your own life, can you recall times of preparation for that which was to come?

Wednesday: 1 Samuel 10:1-27. As Saul steps into this new role as King over Israel, God changes his heart. What has been the biggest change in your life since you decided to follow God and what would others say about you?

Thursday: Psalm 46:1-11. This Psalm is all about discovering the power of God in the midst of chaos, allowing him to be still and experience the peace of God. Who did the Psalmist discover God to be that could help us in our chaos?

Friday: Isaiah 59:1-21. God has already expressed to the people, joy and prosperity as they choose to obey him in Chapter 58 and he now expresses to them that he is able to deal with their sin, bringing light and life. Who do you know that needs the light of Christ to shine in their darkness? Lift them up before God today, whose arm is not short.

Weekend: 1 Corinthians 15:1-11. Quite clearly the gospel had a huge impact upon Paul. How does the gospel affect your life on a daily basis and what evidence can you offer that Christ is alive in your life?
