

5 year Bible reading plan – week 73

Week 73 – w/c 1/4/18

Monday: Mark 3:20-35. Read verse 21 again. At this point not even his mother realised exactly who Jesus was, and they thought they knew what was best for him. In what ways do you sometimes think you know better than Jesus and try to “take charge of him”?

Tuesday: Exodus 14:1-31. In verse 15 God tells Moses to stop praying because he had already told Moses what to do (v1). Moses had passed it on to the people in v13. What has God told you to do that needs your obedience and not more prayer?

Wednesday: 1 Samuel 20:1-42. Jonathan remained a friend to David despite his father’s anger at David. Who are your closest friends? Pray for them. How can you show your appreciation to one of them today?

Thursday: Psalm 55:1-23. Verse 22 is a special promise that God gives to those of us who are followers of Christ. Read it through a few times and then thank God for its truth. Write it out and carry it with you today as a reminder of God’s care for you.

Friday: Jeremiah 4:1-31. Repentance involves outward actions (v1), new commitment (v2) and inward change – surgery on our heart, not simply an outward circumcision. But it is the only way to avoid God’s judgement (v4). Take time to confess your sins and receive his power to change and to forgive today.

Saturday: 2 Corinthians 4:13-18. In what way will you live out verse 18 this weekend? How are you focusing on the invisible spiritual things that are eternal rather than the temporary activities and things in this world?
