

5 year Bible reading plan – week 75

Week 75– w/c 15/4/18

Monday: Mark 4:21-41. Parables are generally stories given to emphasise a single truth. What truth do each of the two parables in verses 26-32 illustrate about living with God as your king? How should you respond to this teaching of Jesus today?

Tuesday: Exodus 16:1-36. God provided the Israelites with bread and meat in response to their grumbling, yet even then some do not obey him or respond in faith. Pray for people you know that God has blessed but who still do not respond in real faith.

Wednesday: 1 Samuel 22:1-23. Ahimelech was killed by Saul for his support of David. David offers refuge to Abiathar his son, with an army made up of “misfits”! Look at verse 2 to see who was in it. Pray that our Church “army” can be as effective with similar people!

Thursday: Proverbs 10:11-21. These proverbs speak into the way we talk, and our attitudes in general. What do you learn from one of them that you can seek to respond to in prayer and lifestyle today?

Friday: Jeremiah 6:1-30. God uses Jeremiah to announce that judgement was coming to Jerusalem, and summarises the reasons in verses 13-15. What similarities are there with our nation today? Pray for the Government and our country that God will bring about a change of attitude.

Saturday: 2 Corinthians 5:11-21. Paul defines what sin is in verse 15 – “Living for ourselves”. But Christ’s death has changed that and we have become new creatures (v17), intended to live for him above all else. What do you need to change to make this more evident in your life?
