## <u>5 year Bible reading plan – week 78</u>

## Week 78 - w/c 6/5/18

**Monday:** Mark 6:1-29. Jesus didn't perform any miracles in his home town, not because of his lack of power but because of the people's lack of faith. Are you limiting the power of God in your life because of your limited understanding or faith?

**Tuesday: Exodus 19:1-25.** Before giving the Ten Commandments, God called Moses and Aaron to meet him on Mount Sinai, but nobody else was permitted to climb the mountain (vv 23, 24). What does this tell you about entering God's Presence?

**Wednesday: 1 Samuel 25:1-44.** Abigail's first husband was a terrible match (probably an arranged marriage) but the servants knew she was a person who could overturn the bad decisions of her husband (vv 14-17). What can you learn from her character that will help you grow in grace?

**Thursday: Proverbs 10:22-32.** We might re-phrase v26 as "Lazy people are a source of irritation for employers!" Either apply this verse in your own life or look at another of these proverbs and re-phrase it in your own language for your life today.

**Friday:** Jeremiah 9:1-26. "An uncircumcised heart" (v26) refers to an outward religious lifestyle without a real inner attitude of faith. This attitude caused Jeremiah to weep over his nation (v1-2). Ask God to move you to tears as you see our nation from his perspective and pray for it.

**Weekend: 2 Corinthians 7:1-7.** The Christian life is full of difficulties, (see v5) but God comforts us and puts people around us to help. Who is an encouragement to you at the present time, and who are you encouraging in their walk of faith?
