

## 5 year Bible reading plan – week 79

### Week 79 – w/c 13/5/18

**Monday: Mark 6:30-44.** Jesus shows concern for the apostles in v31, and for the crowd in v34. How does this encourage you about his concern for you, whatever situation you face?

**Tuesday: Exodus 20:1-26.** In the Ten Commandments, the word for 'you' is singular not plural, even though the Law was given to govern a nation. This reminds us that the character of a nation is dependent on the behaviour and attitude of each individual – you included!

**Wednesday: 1 Samuel 26:1-25.** David once again shows his integrity and faith despite the encouragement of Abishai to kill Saul. Read verses 9 & 10 and spend some time praying for anyone you have a difficult relationship with.

**Thursday: Psalm 59:1-17.** Notice the background of the psalm in the title: Saul's attempt to kill David. Following yesterday's reading, notice David's trust in God to judge his enemies and to protect him. Do you have a similar trust?

**Friday: Jeremiah 10:1-25.** Compare and contrast what this passage says about God and about idols. Pledge your commitment again to the Lord by using verses 23 and 24 as your personal prayer.

**Weekend: 2 Corinthians 7:8-16.** Paul was encouraged by Titus' report on the church at Corinth as well as by the way they responded to his letter to them. How well do you respond to criticism or to correction? Learn to respond correctly and be an encouragement to others.
