

5 year Bible reading plan – week 82

Week 82 – w/c 3/6/18

Monday: Mark 7:24-37. Jesus' apparently negative answer to the non-Jewish woman gave her opportunity to speak a word of wisdom and faith that causes Jesus to act. How easily does your faith give in when God does not answer prayer immediately?

Tuesday: Exodus 23:1-33. Before promising to lead and guide them, God gives Israel some general laws. Should you be following these principles by setting aside one day in seven for rest and spending extra time seeking God three times a year?

Wednesday: 1 Samuel 29:1-11. David had a reputation as a soldier that influenced the Philistines' attitude to him. Does your reputation with non-Christians at work, or among your family or friends, reflect a godly and consistent character?

Thursday: Psalm 62:1-12. What can you do or develop in your behavior or attitude that will enable you to trust God as David does in verses 5 & 6?

Friday: Jeremiah 13:1-27. When God warns Israel about future judgement, using illustrations with a belt (vv1-11) and referring to wineskins (vv12-14), he is encouraging them to repent and avoid disaster. Do people today take the warning of God's judgement seriously? Do you?

Weekend: 2 Corinthians 9:1-15. Read verse 11 again. Write down all the specific riches God has blessed you with e.g. health, friends, work, education, money, resources, opportunities. How can you be more generous with these things so that people will thank God for you?
