

5 year Bible reading plan – week 85

Week 85 – w/c 24/6/18

Monday: Mark 9:1-32 Consider verses 21-24. The boy's father asks Jesus to help his son "if he can". Our God is omnipotent; He is the God of unlimited power. In what situation do you need to overcome your unbelief and have faith that God can change all things?

Tuesday: Exodus 26:1-37 Read Hebrews 9:8 to find the meaning of the curtain that separated the Holy Place from the Most Holy Place. Life and immortality lay hidden till they were brought to light by the gospel. Through the blood of Jesus we have the boldness to enter the holiest of places.

Wednesday: 2 Samuel 1:1-27. David was mourning for not only for his good friend Jonathan but also for his enemy Saul. David had forgiven Saul for the past injuries and hurts. Is there anyone you need to forgive for past hurts? See Proverbs 24:17-18.

Thursday: Psalm 65:1-13. This psalm focuses on God's provision. Spend time praising God for providing for all your needs. Thank God for answered prayers (v2) and pray that God will still the turmoil of the nations (v7).

Friday: Jeremiah 16:1-21. None of the sins of sinners can be hidden from God, or shall be overlooked by him. Consider Psalm 139:23-24. Ask God to highlight any areas of sin in your life and spend some time in repentance. Thank God that He is our refuge and strength.

Weekend: 2 Corinthians 11:1-15. Paul is warning the Corinthian Church about false teachers who were preaching a different gospel. Are you grounding yourself in Scripture to guard yourself from false teachings?
