

5 year Bible reading plan – week 86

Week 86 - 01/07/18

Monday: Mark 9:33-50. Here we see the disciples arguing about who was the greatest. What is the lesson for the disciples when it comes to power, control and leadership that Jesus teaches them, that we should apply to our own lives?

Tuesday: Exodus 27:1-21. When the Israelites offered sacrifices at the altar, seeing the horns symbolized safety, refuge and atonement. Today as you come before God, you can find refuge, safety and forgiveness.

Wednesday: 2 Samuel 2:1-32. Over the course of time, David continued to submit to God's timing for his future. He enquired of the Lord and waited for his answer. What are you seeking an answer to? Wait patiently and God will answer and give direction just as he did for David.

Thursday: Psalm 66:1 - 67:7. As the Psalmist looks back over his journey, he recognizes some of the difficulties that they faced, but God brought them through. What have you learnt about God through difficult moments in your life that you can praise him for?

Friday: Jeremiah 17:1-27. What times of spiritual drought have you experienced in your walk and what brought this about? How and what did you need to change? What have you learnt from these verses concerning this issue?

Weekend: 2 Corinthians 11:16-33. While others are boasting in themselves, Paul boasts about his servanthood and suffering for the sake of the gospel. What has your concern for the gospel cost you in comparison to Paul?
