

5 year Bible reading plan – week 90

Week 90 - 29/07/18

Monday: Mark 11:1-19 Jesus cursed the fig tree because it looked luscious but was fruitless. What are some examples of how we sometimes bear lots of leaves but no fruit? What is the difference between leaves and fruit?

Tuesday: Exodus 31:1 - 32:6 Verses 12-17 highlight the importance of the Sabbath. It is made clear that we must set apart a time for God which is wholly for Him, a time when nothing intrudes to prevent our whole attention being on Him. Set aside a day this week to focus on God, rest and be refreshed.

Wednesday: 2 Samuel 5:1-25 In verses 19 and 23 David inquired of the Lord before he went into battle. Read Proverbs 3:3-5. Spend some time inquiring of the Lord and listening for His answer.

Thursday: Proverbs 12:1-9 Read verse 6 again. The words we speak are powerful. Use your words today to encourage someone and build them up. Write a short note or text someone to encourage them in their spiritual walk today.

Friday: Jeremiah 21:1-14 Jeremiah told the people of Jerusalem that the only way to save themselves was to surrender to the Babylonians. This is an enduring spiritual principle: When we struggle against God, our only hope of success is in surrender. What do you need to surrender to God today?

Weekend: Galatians 1:1-10 People were trying to pervert the gospel because the true gospel is offensive to our human, sinful nature. It offends our pride that we cannot save ourselves. It offends our knowledge as it goes against our scientific knowledge and personal experience. Can you clearly summarise the true gospel? See 1 Corinthians 15:1-4.
