

5 year Bible reading plan – week 91

Week 91 - 05/08/18

Monday: Mark 11:20-33 V24 does not mean if you pray hard enough and really believe, that God is obligated to answer your prayer no matter what. That is not faith in God; but rather faith in faith or feelings. Pray in faith that God will move mountains knowing that God does not always answer our prayers in the way we want or expect.

Tuesday: Exodus 32:7-35 God knew that he was not going to destroy Israel. He purposely put Moses in the position of intercession to develop Moses' heart for the people. Moses prayed as if heaven and earth depended on him. Pray for our nation today with the same passion as Moses.

Wednesday: 2 Samuel 6:1-23 David was dancing for all his might before the Lord. He was not concerned about what others thought about the way he praised his God. Are you so concerned about what others think about you that you hold back in your worship to God? Are you prepared to be undignified in your worship?

Thursday: Psalm 70:1 - 71:24 These psalms are a petition to God for help and refuge. We may not have been through such intense trials as David but we can see God's mighty hand in our lives each and every day. Use some of the characteristics of God described in these psalms to praise God today.

Friday: Jeremiah 22:1-30 In v16 God praises King Josiah because "he defended the cause of the poor and needy". This was evidence of knowing God. How are you living this out in your life? See 1 John 3:16-18. Spend some time in prayer for CAP and the food bank.

Weekend: Galatians 1:11-24 Before turning to Christ Paul persecuted the church of God. God has the power to change even the most stubborn of hearts. Pray for your non-Christian friends that God will soften their hearts to the Gospel message.
