

Monday: Leviticus 8:1-12. Consider: Despite Aaron leading Israel's idolatry with the golden calf (Exodus 32), God gives him a second chance, setting him apart as the High Priest. Sometimes past mistakes make us feel that God would never use us. What is God setting you apart to do, despite your past failures?

Tuesday: Numbers 13:1 - 14:12. Think: What can we learn from the way both sides handle the negative report, that we can apply in our own lives?

Wednesday: Numbers 22:21-38. Reflect: Like Balaam, sometimes we can be stubborn in our ways and we need to hear God say, "I have come because your path is reckless" (v32). Is this true of you in any way at the present time?

Thursday: Deuteronomy 31:1-8. Preparation: Things were about to change not only for the people of Israel but also for Joshua. What were the main points that Moses made to them that we can apply to our own lives?

Friday: Deuteronomy 34. Key verse: "For no one has ever shown the mighty power or performed the awesome deeds that Moses did in the sight of all Israel" v12. Thank God that Jesus has been found worthy of greater honour than Moses (Heb 3:2-3). Today rededicate your life to serve the Lord faithfully & thank Him for his faithfulness towards us.

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
