

**Monday: Luke 22:7-34. Affirm your faith:** Verses 13, 21 and 34 reveal Jesus being aware of future events and circumstances. It's great to know that Jesus already knows what lies ahead and can never be caught unawares even if we can! That is enough for us to rest our faith upon.

**Tuesday: Mark 14:32-52. Consider:** As a man, Jesus went through an emotionally and spiritually burdensome period and needed his disciples to hold him up in prayer. How important it is to hold up our Leaders in prayer so that they are strengthened in all things.

**Wednesday: Matthew 26:57-75.** Peter disowned Jesus in a moment of stress and weakness. In which situations, and in what ways, are you most likely to disown Christ? Thank God He is gracious and forgiving with us, as well as with Peter!

**Thursday: Matthew 27:1-26. Consider verse 18.** What was it about Jesus that the Pharisees and Sadducees "envied"? His genuine spirituality? His popularity? His power and ability to heal? The impact of his genuine humility? Instead of opposing Jesus, these should cause us to bow in worship!

**Friday: Luke 23:26-49. Key verse: v34.** In the hour of his greatest personal pain, Jesus prayed, and His prayer reveals his heart attitude of grace, and His concern for sinful human beings. If your prayers were recorded what would they reveal about your priorities and attitudes? Would they reflect similar priorities as those of Jesus?

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
