

**Monday: Matthew 27:57-66. Challenge:** Joseph had influence as a wealthy Jewish leader but was also a secret disciple. His love for Jesus gave him boldness despite the danger, and this act blew his cover and revealed his faith. Do you love Jesus enough to risk everything?

**Tuesday: John 20:1-18. Consider:** Mary found an empty tomb, and thought the body had been moved. John found an empty tomb and believed that Jesus had risen (v8). Both later met the Risen Lord and understood the scriptures. All disciples grow by knowing Jesus is alive and understanding the Bible.

**Wednesday: Luke 24:13-35. Reflect:** v16 - How often had Jesus walked with us and we have been kept from recognising him? v28 – Has Jesus ever tested your faith hunger for the things of God by acting as if he were going to walk away?

**Thursday: Proverbs 13:20-25. Listen:** Ask God to speak to you and then read these verses through twice more and see which thought stands out. How will you respond to what God is drawing your attention to today?

**Friday: Proverbs 14:2-12. Think:** The fear of God mentioned in v2, is mentioned often in the Bible, as both a motivator and a consequence of living with a right attitude of respect and awe towards God. Do you “fear” Jesus as well as love Him?

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
