- You may book in up to 9 days in advance for each service for one of the 45 spaces available. (Fully booked for this Sunday.)
- If you book and then can't make it, please text 07775 666869 so that those on the waiting list can take your place.
- Places can also be booked for Seedlings, 2:40 Tribe and Creche via ChurchSuite but don't forget to book adult places if you book your children in. (No need to book for Face2Faith.)
- If you are involved in any kind of ministry on a given Sunday (eg, Seedlings, ushering, band, tech team) you **don't need to book a place** for that week.

### Church Finances

We appreciate so many who give regularly to the Church and it's ministry and thank God for our offerings in April which amounted to £11,179.27. We are in the process of buying new stackable chairs and arranging for the main Church roof to be re-roofed, at a cost of around £10,500 and £34,000 respectively. If you are able to make an interest free loan available to us for a minimum of 12 months to save us interest charges as we fund this, please chat with Alan or Jane.

It looks likely that the church building will be used as a vaccination centre over the coming months and volunteers will be needed to help with this.
