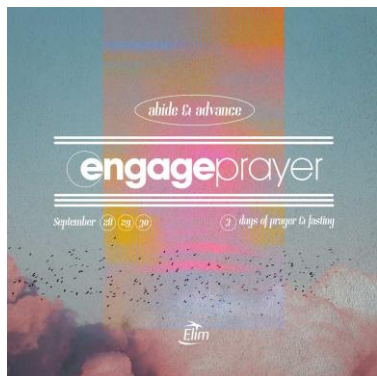
We would like to thank Sarah Robinson for re-varnishing the church doors over the summer. She's done a great job and we appreciate the time and effort she has spent doing this.
