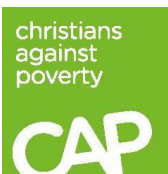
### Live meetings at St. Paul's on Sundays

"What do you do when it is still winter in Paraguay and members of church tell you they want to get baptised, and they don't want to wait for summer? Pray you don't freeze in the cold river water and plan a Sunday that looks to be as warm as it possibly can for the time of year!

We were encouraged and honestly surprised after a series of teaching which included baptisms that four church members were insistent that they wanted to get baptised as soon as possible regardless of the weather. Here in Paraguay people will go weeks without washing their hair during winter because they don't want to get their heads wet and cold. So to say they were willing to be fully immersed in cold river water blew us away.



We were joyful as the day came round, a beautiful sunny day when we went down to the water. It especially moved us to see one of the ladies who had not been our biggest fan when we first started building links with the communities take this step of faith and see how different a person she is now is. God is good. Please pray for them all and their families, that they will see blessings and growth in their lives and be filled with Joy and Peace. There are more who are wanting to be baptised. How cool is that! Thank you for supporting our work here in Paraguay, it is days like that Sunday down in the waters that encourage us to keep pressing on, as we get to celebrate with the Heavenly hosts, for the growth of His Kingdom here on earth."
