

Bible Readings Book by Book week 2 – w/c 14/11/21

Monday: Genesis 7:1-24. The flood was a devastating judgement upon the appalling selfishness and evil of people. Yet God graciously saves Noah and offers a new beginning. Today is a new day for you! Confess yesterday's mistakes and re-commit to serving Jesus!

Tuesday: Genesis 8:1-22. Noah's first act upon coming out of the ark was one of sacrifice and worship. God's response was to promise never to judge the earth in this way again. Offer up your praise as a sacrifice to God today, and listen for his encouraging words of promise for your life.

Wednesday: Genesis 9:1-29. After the flood, God gave Noah and his descendants a covenant promise. As you have gone through difficult moments, what promises or words of encouragement did you receive that gave you hope?

Thursday: Genesis 10:1-32. Nimrod is singled out as a hunter and a warrior king, (vv8-12) and reference is made to his relationship with God. When people describe you, is your involvement with Jesus something that is obvious?

Friday: Genesis 11:1-32. Often the words we use and the way we speak reveal our attitudes and motives. Read v4 again and notice who they were building the city for and why. Ask yourself the question: Who am I living for today and why?

Weekend: Genesis 12:1-20. Abram obeyed God and did not delay in moving on, even though he was short on specifics. Abram's life is a model of faith in action, trusting in the promises of God. What do you need to trust God for in your life?
