

### **Bible Readings Book by Book week 3 – w/c 21/11/21**

**Monday: Genesis 13:1-18** Verses 10 - 13 give us an insight into Lot's motives for his choice. It was based on the physical characteristics of the area, rather than the morality of its residents. Do you make choices on a different and better basis?

**Tuesday: Genesis 14:1-24** Abram is very clear in verses 23-24 that his financial blessings came from God. He wouldn't accept gifts from others that would distract his faith or God's glory. Would you have been tempted to accept the reward?

**Wednesday: Genesis 15:1-21** As God passed between the slaughtered animals, this spoke of a person's good faith, guaranteeing a person's word and promise. God was faithful to his promises and he will be towards those promises that he has given to you.

**Thursday: Genesis 16:1-16** Despite Sarah & Abraham's weaknesses, God still used them! If God asked you the question he asked Hagar in v8, would you be clear about your vision and service for God in the next 12 months or so?

**Friday: Genesis 17:1-27** Abraham had a new experience of God at the age of 99 that made a very private and personal impression upon him! Despite his doubts in verses 17-18, he still responded in immediate faith (v23).

**Weekend: Genesis 18:1-15** What a wonderful truth for each of us to ponder today that when we face tasks that seem impossible, the Lord says, "Is anything too hard for me?".
