

Bible Readings Book by Book week 4 – w/c 28/11/21

Monday: Genesis 18:16-33 Abraham's repetition demonstrated his sincere desire to save his relatives. Who are you interceding for and what will you do, to see them take a step closer to knowing Christ?

Tuesday: Genesis 19:1-38 Notice v16. Lot had made a bad choice to settle near Sodom, and even now hesitated to leave when judgement was coming! Is there anything that you cling to, when you should be leaving it behind?

Wednesday: Genesis 20:1-18 Abraham deceives Abimelech assuming wrongly that Abimelech would not respect God (v11). Don't make wrong assumptions about people's responses an excuse to not share your faith or invite them to Church!

Thursday: Genesis 21:1-34 Sometimes we find ourselves in desert places without water, running on empty, with no hope. Today, we have assurance that God hears our cry, he opens our eyes bringing clear direction and he refreshes and strengthens us for the journey ahead.

Friday: Genesis 22:1-24 This chapter illustrates Abraham's faith and obedience and points us to the One who understands what it is to sacrifice a Son for the benefit of others. Real faith when tested always comes out stronger!

Weekend: Genesis 23:1-20 The promise of God is so real to Abraham that he buries Sarah in Canaan, the land of promise, rather than returning to bury her in his father's land, as the usual custom was. What do you do differently from others that reflects your faith in God's word?
