

Bible Readings Book by Book week 6 – w/c 12/12/21

Monday: Genesis 27:41 - 28:9 Sometimes when we can't see or understand how God's promises are going to work out, we take things into our own hands. Just remember, we can't thwart the ultimate purpose of God, so why not work with Him and not against Him and trust Him in all areas of your life?

Tuesday: Genesis 28:10-22 Notice Jacob's realization of God's presence, and what his response is. Respect, worship, commitment and generosity are all evident. How do you respond when you experience the presence of God?

Wednesday: Genesis 29:1-30 Jacob, the master deceiver, is deceived by Laban, but still works for a further 7 years to get Rachel as his wife. What are your important goals that are worth waiting and sacrificing for?

Thursday: Genesis 29:31 - 30:24 When the bible uses the word "remember" in v22, it means more than simple recollection. It is to act lovingly, with concern and care towards another. When has God remembered you in your difficult moments?

Friday: Genesis 30:25-43. Jacob has been converted but his old deceitful nature is still evident when he deals with Laban, who is as cunning as he is! Who or what causes you to demonstrate your sinful nature rather than your new life in Christ, and what can you do to avoid it?

Weekend: Genesis 31:1-21. Jacob heard God's voice in part through the people around him. Laban and his sons' attitudes made him seek God's will. In what ways do the people around you point you to Jesus?
