

### **Bible Readings Book by Book week 11 – w/c 16/1/22**

**Monday: Exodus 2:1-25.** The comment made by the man in v14, would one day become a reality, where Moses would rule, judge and deliver his people, however, Moses wasn't ready at this stage. As you look back over your own life, can you recall times of preparation for that which was to come?

**Tuesday: Exodus 3:1-22.** God got Moses' attention when he saw a bush that was burning but not consumed by the fire. What has God done in your life to get your attention? How open are you to hearing his voice today?

**Wednesday: Exodus 4:1-31.** Moses' weaknesses and insecurities are obvious, especially in verse 13, "send someone else". Despite your weakness and struggles ask God to change you and offer yourself to him to do whatever he asks you to do.

**Thursday: Exodus 5:1-23.** Moses had just done what God had told him to do and yet he seemed to be under major pressure. What is the closest you have come to suffering a temporary setback when you tried to do what you thought God wanted you to do? What did you learn from that experience?

**Friday: Exodus 6:1-30.** When Moses & Aaron told Pharaoh to let God's people go, things got worse, but God changed everything by just one word: 'Now'. God is ready with a plan, a word of encouragement to Moses that by his mighty hand, he will bring about change. Today, there is nothing too difficult for God.

**Weekend: Exodus 7:1-25.** Notice how old Moses and Aaron are in v7. Our age and experience must never be a hindrance to obedience. Whatever your age God can call you to do something new to make an impact. Are you listening for his voice?
