Bible Readings Book by Book week 15 – w/c 13/2/22

Monday: Exodus 26:1-37 Read Hebrews 9:8 to find the meaning of the curtain that separated the Holy Place from the Most Holy Place. Life and immortality lay hidden till they were brought to light by the gospel. Through the blood of Jesus we have the boldness to enter the holiest of places.

Tuesday: Exodus 27:1-21 When the Israelites offered sacrifices at the altar, seeing the horns symbolized safety, refuge and atonement. Today as you come before God, you can find refuge, safety and forgiveness.

Wednesday: Exodus 28:1-43 When Aaron came into the Lord's presence, there were two things over his heart: the people that mattered to him, the 12 tribes (v29), and the means of making right decisions (v30). Ask God to bless those on your heart today or pray for help in the choices you must make today.

Thursday: Exodus 29:1-46 The consecration of the priests seems like an elaborate and often bloody ritual. Thank God that Jesus came to be the Great High Priest, so we no longer need earthly priests to act as intermediaries between us and God.

Friday: Exodus 30:1-38 As God gives clear instruction on the building of the tabernacle, its furnishings and the incense, it was a reminder that God provided a place for man to meet with him and that man could lift up his prayers before God like incense. Come, meet with God today and lift up your requests before him.

Weekend: Exodus 31:1 - 32:6 Verses 12-17 highlight the importance of the Sabbath. It is made clear that we must set apart a time for God which is wholly for Him, a time when nothing intrudes to prevent our whole attention being on Him. Set aside a day this week to focus on God, rest and be refreshed.
