Bible Readings Book by Book week 16 – w/c 20/2/22

Week 16

Monday: Exodus 32:7-35 God knew that he was not going to destroy Israel. He purposely put Moses in the position of intercession to develop Moses' heart for the people. Moses prayed as if heaven and earth depended on him. Pray for our nation today with the same passion as Moses.

Tuesday: Exodus 33:1-23. Moses spent time in prayer before serving the people (v11). Joshua however stayed in God's presence, in preparation for future leadership. What season of life are you in? Praying and serving, or a period of preparation for future ministry? Are you more of a Joshua or more of a Moses at the present time?

Wednesday: Exodus 34:1-35 Moses' relationship with God is so close his face shines and the people cannot look at him. Do you want to be so close to God that people can see it on your face? Use some of the attributes in v6-7 to praise God today.

Thursday: Exodus 35:1-29. Look at verses 21, 26 & 29. Only those who were willing brought offerings. God only accepts things given willingly and what is given out of duty or compulsion attracts no reward from him. Are you committed enough to his work to give willingly, generously, and cheerfully?

Friday: Exodus 35:30 - 36:38 God called Bezalel and Oholiab by name. God equipped them with a special outpouring of the Holy Spirit giving them the wisdom, understanding and knowledge needed to build the tabernacle. What has God called you to do? What are your God given skills and abilities?

Weekend: Exodus 37:1-29. In the temple everything was overlaid with gold. No expense was spared when it came to giving praise and worship to God! Do you give of your best and are you generous and extravagant in expressing your praise and thanks to God?
