## Bible Readings Book by Book week 35 – w/c 3/7/22

## **Week 35**

**Monday:** Psalm 3:1-8. This psalm was written as David fled from his son who had incited a rebellion against him. What does verse 3 reveal about David's understanding of God? In what ways is your experience and view of God similar or different from his?

**Tuesday: Psalm 4:1 - 5:12.** Make Ps 5:3 your example as you focus on the fact that God hears prayer and lift up your needs to Him with expectant faith today.

**Wednesday: Psalm 6:1 - 7:17.** Both of these Psalms are a cry to God to intervene when others attack us. Psalm 7:4 & 5 clearly express a sense of injustice, and give us a prayer to pray when unjustly attacked: "If we deserve this then let our enemies prevail, but if not, Lord deliver us!"

**Thursday: Psalm 8:1-9.** When David looked at Creation (v3) it brought him a sense of perspective about people in general and his own life in particular. Seeing God's greatness compared to our weakness should always produce awe and worship!

**Friday: Psalm 9:1-20.** Whatever happens in our life, verses 9 & 10 remain true. Write them on a piece of paper and memorise them as a constant reminder of God's goodness. Take time to thank him for his faithfulness.

**Weekend: Psalm 10:1-18.** What stands out in this psalm for you? Turn it into an expression of praise to God!
