

## Bible Readings Book by Book week 37 – w/c 17/7/22

### Week 37

**Monday: Psalm 18:32-50.** David praises God because of past victories. Make a list of 10 things God has done for you and use it to give him thanks today!

**Tuesday: Psalm 19:1-14.** God gave us divine law as both warning and promises. What benefits does the Psalmist reveal to us as we choose to live in his will?

**Wednesday: Psalm 20:1-9.** Think of someone you care about and pray today that they will experience God in the ways mentioned in verses 1-4 in the coming months.

**Thursday: Psalm 21:1-13.** In Psalm 20 they prayed for victory. In Psalm 21 they gave thanks and rejoiced in past blessings, God's strength, answered prayer, royal status, long life, many victories, God's presence, unfailing love (v 1-7) and future victories (v 8-12). What will you give thanks for today?

**Friday: Psalm 22:1-18.** This Psalm is known as the psalm of the cross, as David prophetically writes words that Jesus used when being crucified. It gives us an insight into his pain and suffering. What speaks to you in these verses? Respond to them in praise and prayer.

**Weekend: Psalm 22:19-31.** David is under siege by enemies. He feels hopeless and alone, even deserted by God but then in v19-21 he affirms God to be his strength and Saviour. Through his struggles he declares in v22, "I will praise you". Praise God in all circumstances today.
