

Bible Readings Book by Book week 39 – w/c 31/7/22

Week 39

Monday: Psalm 31:1-24. Can you say with the same confidence as David that “my times are in your hands”? Do you recognize that everything that happens to you is under His sovereign control? Can you praise Him in every circumstance?

Tuesday: Psalm 32:1-11. The Psalmist encourages us to trust in God. When we allow Him to guide us we can:- 1. Depend on His ‘Promises’, ‘I will’. 2. Trust in his ‘Purposes’. 3. Be assured of his ‘Presence’.

Wednesday: Psalm 33:1-22. Use this psalm as a declaration of your praise today. Choose 2 or 3 verses that speak to you and put them into your own words as your worship to God.

Thursday: Psalm 34:1-22. As the Psalmist reflects a little in vv19-22 he discovers that, troubles will come, the wicked will be punished, but no matter what we face, God will deliver, protect, redeem and will not condemn, those who take refuge in him.

Friday: Psalm 35:1-28. David moves here from a position of persecution at the start of the psalm to a place of praise in the final verses. The only thing that changes is his attitude as he reaffirms his faith. You can change your outlook in a similar manner.

Weekend: Psalm 36:1-12. Here, the righteous seem to be those who may do evil but generally seek to please God. The wicked are those who, despite good they may do, generally reject God’s ways. What aspects of each do you see in your own life?
