

Bible Readings Book by Book week 58 – w/c 11/12/22

Week 58

Monday: Romans 1:18-32. These verses reveal God's attitude towards sin and reveals the guilt of those who do not acknowledge God. Summarise verses 18-20 in your own words, and then use it to pray for people you know who are not true disciples.

Tuesday: Romans 2:1-16. This passage focuses on God's judgment and the importance of it. It lets us know that the only way of salvation is through God's grace. What event in your life led you to appreciate God's grace?

Wednesday: Romans 2:17-29. The apostle makes it clear that birth and outward conformity does not count. A "Jew" is one who experiences the Spirit in his life (vv 27, 28). Outward conformity is less important than an inward relationship with Jesus.

Thursday: Romans 3:1-18. Being entrusted with God's truth has value, but in itself does not deal with our sin. It points us to the One who can forgive sin and give us a new start. Like Israel, are you in danger of missing the main truth and assuming that knowing the Bible is enough?

Friday: Romans 3:19-31. Paul explains that Christ's death is the ultimate, final and complete sacrifice for sin. Christ took upon himself the full weight of God's wrath which we deserved. Thank God today for his grace and mercy towards us.

Weekend: Romans 4:1-15. Paul is emphasizing that people have always been saved by faith alone. It is when we believe what God says that we obtain what he promises. Faith is agreeing that what God says is true despite the circumstances or what we feel! Confess your faith in Him again today!
