Bible Readings Book by Book week 60 – w/c 25/12/22

Week 60

Monday: Romans 7:13-25. This passage teaches that we all sin, even when we try and do good. We all mess up because of our sinful nature. But because of Jesus we can receive forgiveness and a new start each time we fail. How can you help others not to fall into temptation today?

Tuesday: Romans 8:1-25. Paul talks about a battle that goes on in our lives between the sinful nature and the Spirit. What disciplines or practices do you have to centre your thoughts on God each day?

Wednesday: Romans 8:26-39. Commenting on v28, Dallas Willard says "Nothing irredeemable has happened or can happen to us on our way to our destiny in God's full world." Do you believe that?

Thursday: Romans 9:1-13. The real children of God are not the nation of Israel, but those who are Abraham's children by faith, and Paul is concerned for those who have not yet believed despite the opportunities they had. Pray for people you know who are not yet God's children by faith.

Friday: Romans 9:14-29. Paul used Exodus 33:19 to show the freedom of God's mercy. How do you feel about God's authority to choose who will be objects of his mercy?

Weekend: Romans 9:30 - 10:13. Give thanks to God today for your salvation recognizing that it's not about what you have done, but it's all about what Christ has done on the cross.
