Bible Readings Book by Book week 69 – w/c 26/2/23

Week 69

Monday: Deuteronomy 31:30 - 32:21. God's love and care for Israel is expressed here in poetic language. One thing made God angry above all others. Read v 16 to see what it is. Do you allow other things to become "gods" or "idols" and take God's central position?

Tuesday: Deuteronomy 32:22-52 After Moses recited the words of this song he encouraged the Israelites saying that if they obeyed these words they would live long in the land of Canaan. We also need to see and understand, from an eternal perspective, that it is not a futile thing to love and obey God. Praise God that there is no other god besides him, that he is sovereign and has an eternal plan.

Wednesday: Deuteronomy 33:1-29. The first part of v27 is one of the most precious promises in the Bible. Thank God today that whatever situation we face we can take refuge in God, and know that he is holding us in his arms for all eternity.

Thursday: Deuteronomy 34:1-12 In this passage Moses wasn't described as the Prince of Egypt or as a prophet or as a miracle worker. He is described as a servant of God. What are you doing to be a good and faithful servant of God?

Friday: Joshua 1:1-18. Joshua was called to step into Moses shoes and lead Israel. It was a daunting task, and 3 times he is told to "be strong and courageous". What do you need to ask God to give you strength for at this present season of your life?

Weekend: Joshua 2:1-24. Rahab is a traitor to her people, choosing instead to identify with God's people. She becomes an ancestor of Jesus (Matthew 1:5) and a hero of faith (Hebrews 11:31). Thank God that he still changes people, freeing us from our past to become people of significance!
