## Bible Readings Book by Book week 70 – w/c 5/3/23

## **Week 70**

**Monday: Joshua 3:1-17.** After 40 years, the day has finally come for the Israelites to enter the Promised Land. As they move forward there were some important steps to follow. What were the instructions that were given that we can apply to our own lives?

**Tuesday: Joshua 4:1-24.** The pile of stones was a reminder of God's power to pass onto the next generation (v6), as well as having an immediate impact (v26). What do you do to remind yourself of answered prayer and God's past miracles?

**Wednesday: Joshua 5:1-15.** Some of Joshua's second-generation Believers had not been circumcised and so there was a need to re-emphasise it (v2). What values and practices do you need to re-affirm to ensure you do not lose something of vital importance?

**Thursday: Joshua 6:1-27.** Joshua and the people of Israel were about to experience the collapse of the walls of Jericho. What can we learn from them in the way they saw the walls dismantled before their eyes?

**Friday: Joshua 7:1-26.** Sin and compromise always make us weak and cause us to fail when our enemy attacks. Sin always requires judgement. Take time to examine yourself, confess your sins, and look to Jesus, who took God's anger and judgement instead of us.

**Weekend: Joshua 8:1-35.** Keeping the plunder caused judgement last time round, but now God allows them to keep it (v2). What matters is not what we have, buy, or possess, but our attitude of surrender and obedience to God. Keep your heart and motives pure!
