Bible Readings Book by Book week 72 – w/c 19/3/23

<u>Week 72</u>

Monday: Joshua 14:1-15. It was said of Caleb, that he had a different spirit (Numbers 14:24). Even after 45 years of waiting, he held on to God's promises. What do you see in his character that inspires you?

Tuesday: Joshua 15:1-63. Notice Acsah's request. She recognized that owning land in the desert was not enough without springs of water. Thank God that even in the desert place, we can experience the living water of the Spirit.

Wednesday: Joshua 16:1-10. God allotted part of the promised land to each tribe but they still had to occupy the land that was the home of other tribes and people. Have you fully entered into the inheritance God has given you, or do you allow other people to set the boundaries of your spiritual experience?

Thursday: Joshua 17:1-18. The people of Joseph felt restricted, longed for more room but were afraid of the enemy. Joshua encouraged them to go and take hold of the land, to focus on who they were and what they could do in God. Don't allow the enemy to hold you back, but take hold of everything God has for you.

Friday: Joshua 18:1-28. For some reason seven tribes hesitated in taking possession of that which God had given to them. What are you holding back from in your own life and why? What can we learn from Joshua in the way that he dealt with the problem?

Weekend: Joshua 19:1-48. Why did God give Simeon's tribe land from within Judah, according to verse 9? Can you give to others what you have that is more than you need?
