## Bible Readings Book by Book week 73 – w/c 26/3/23

## <u>Week 73</u>

**Monday: Joshua 19:49 - 20:9.** God was laying the foundation for a new nation and right at the heart of it he makes provision for refuge and forgiveness for accidental killing. Thank God that Christ's death makes forgiveness of any sin possible.

**Tuesday: Joshua 21:1-45.** List the many things God had done for Israel (vv 43-45). What aspects of the Lord's nature shine through these blessings?

**Wednesday: Joshua 22:1-34.** Misunderstanding of other people's motives almost caused a civil war! Honest conversation saved the day! Is there anyone you need to chat with honestly and openly in order to "clear the air"?

**Thursday: Joshua 23:1-16.** Joshua's greatest concern for Israel as he steps down is obvious from v16! If the leaders stepped down tomorrow, in your group or Church, what would be your greatest concern? Pray that God will give you and others strength to "not turn away" (v12).

**Friday: Joshua 24:1-33.** Joshua reminds Israel that God alone has achieved the victory, from Abraham to the present moment. He reminds them of God's faithfulness and also sets a challenge to serve the Lord wholeheartedly. How will you serve God this week?

**Weekend: Mark 1:1-20.** As Jesus approached the fishermen and called out to them, they left everything and followed Jesus. How long did it take for you to make up your mind to follow Jesus? What things are holding back your non-Christian friends from following Jesus? Pray specifically into that area of their lives.
