Bible Readings Book by Book week 103 – w/c 22/10/23

Week 103

Monday: Psalm 63:1 - 64:10. In Psalm 63, the Psalmist David expresses God's presence with him at all times; whether in the desert, the temple, the long lonely night hours or even in the battle. He also knew God's right hand of power and authority would deliver him. Today we can have assurance that God is with us at all times.

Tuesday: Psalm 65:1-13. This psalm focuses on God's provision. Spend time praising God for providing for all your needs. Thank God for answered prayers (v2) and pray that God will still the turmoil of the nations (v7).

Wednesday: Psalm 66:1 - 67:7. As the Psalmist looks back over his journey, he recognizes some of the difficulties that they faced, but God brought them through. What have you learnt about God through difficult moments in your life that you can praise him for?

Thursday: Psalm 68:1-35 This psalm praises God for His power, might and strength. V4 tells us to "sing to God, sing in praise of his name". Put on your favourite worship music and praise Him for being an awesome God (v35).

Friday: Psalm 69:1-36. The Psalmist finds himself being mistreated & falsely accused for crimes he has not done. What do we learn from the way that he deals with this that we can apply in our own situations?

Weekend: Psalm 70:1 - 71:24 These psalms are a petition to God for help and refuge. We may not have been through such intense trials as David but we can see God's mighty hand in our lives each and every day. Use some of the characteristics of God described in these psalms to praise God today.
