

Bible Readings Book by Book week 100 – w/c 1/10/23

Week 100

Monday: Psalm 42:1 - 43:5. In both Psalms, during periods of depression and difficulty, the author comes to the same conclusion in the final verse. Write it out and place it in a place where you will read it, for when you are struggling spiritually.

Tuesday: Psalm 44:1-26. The psalmist seems to be struggling. They have heard and been told of how God moved in years gone by, but why is God silent now? How is your faith in God's justice and love affected when it appears that God is neglecting you in your situation?

Wednesday: Psalm 45:1-17. This Psalm is a wedding song and has an application to Jesus and His Church. Verses 6 & 7 are quoted in Hebrews about Jesus. What do you learn about Him in these verses that you can turn into worship and praise?

Thursday: Psalm 46:1-11. This Psalm is all about discovering the power of God in the midst of chaos, allowing him to be still and experience the peace of God. Who did the Psalmist discover God to be that could help us in our chaos?

Friday: Psalm 47:1-9. Read each verse of today's Psalm as an expression of praise. Use it as a springboard to speak out a response to God in worship in your own words – 9 sentences that become your psalm of praise for today.

Weekend: Psalm 48:1-14. Verse 8 states the principal theme of the Psalm - God makes the city secure. Though they had heard how God protected his own, as they worshipped God, they saw how God is the true source of protection and security forever.
