Bible Readings Book by Book week 120 - w/c 19/2/24

<u>Week 120</u>

Monday: Proverbs 12:1-9 Read verse 6 again. The words we speak are powerful. Use your words today to encourage someone and build them up. Write a short note or text someone to encourage them in their spiritual walk today.

Tuesday: Proverbs 12:10-19 Several of these verses focus on lying and sinful talk. We all fall into the trap of using our words in a way that is not honouring God or others. Pray that your words will be wise and not reckless.

Wednesday: Proverbs 12:20-28. Read verse 26 again. Are you careful that the friends you have, and the people you spend time with are encouraging your walk with God, and not influencing you in the wrong way?

Thursday: Galatians 1:1-10 People were trying to pervert the gospel because the true gospel is offensive to our human, sinful nature. It offends our pride that we cannot save ourselves. It offends our knowledge as it goes against our scientific knowledge and personal experience. Can you clearly summarise the true gospel? See 1 Corinthians 15:1-4.

Friday: Galatians 1:11-24 Before turning to Christ Paul persecuted the church of God. God has the power to change even the most stubborn of hearts. Pray for your non-Christian friends that God will soften their hearts to the Gospel message.

Weekend: Galatians 2:1-10. Paul continues telling his personal experience and how his ministry was recognized by the other apostles. Any ministry we have should be recognized by other leaders, and this is part of God's call to serve. Would you be confident that what you are doing to serve the Lord would have the recognition and support of your group and Church Leaders?
